- 1. Three specimens collected at 2-3 day intervals are recommended.
- 2. For an O&P Exam, the patient must have a travel history outside North America in the last 6 weeks or a suspected parasite. With no travel history, perform a Parasite Screen.
- 3. Collect specimens after onset of symptoms. Peak virus is 3-5 days after onset. Declining virus 8-9 days after onset.
