## **CATHETER TIP COLLECTION**

#### **PRINCIPLE**

Intravascular catheters such as central lines, CVP, Hickman, Broviac, arterial lines and Swan-Ganz are submitted for culture following their removal. Under normal conditions, it would be expected that they are sterile. Urinary catheters are unacceptable for culture and will be rejected.

#### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Cleanse the skin around the catheter site with alcohol.
- 2. Aseptically remove catheter and clip 5cm of the distal tip of the catheter directly into a sterile container.
- 3. Label with patient name and date of birth and submit to laboratory within 15 minutes to prevent drying. Maintain at room temperature.
