## PROCEDURE FOR USING CULTURETTES (AEROBIC CULTURES)

- 1. Peel open the BBL CultureSwab pouch.
- 2. Remove the cap from the transport tube.
- 3. Remove the applicator swab and collect the sample. The applicator tip should only touch the area where the infection is suspected to minimize possible contamination.
- 4. Replace the applicator swab into the transport tube.
- 5. Label the patient name and date of birth on tube label.
- 6. Send specimen to laboratory for analysis.
- 7. BBL CultureSwab devices maintain a viability of most organisms for 24-48 hours, however fastidious organisms such as Neisseria gonorrhoeae and Streptococcus pneumoniae should be transported to the lab and cultured within 24 hours.
